Job Title: Part-time Environmental Health Analyst

Office Location: New Haven, CT

Job Description: We are looking for an environmental or public health analyst with solid statistical evaluation skills and interest in environmental health questions. We are a quick-moving group that thrives on creativity and flexibility in addressing the complex risks brought about by shale gas and oil extraction, processing, and transport. Responsibilities include:

- Working collaboratively with staff in the Pennsylvania office on data analysis and management;
- Analyzing data to incorporate into community reports based on air monitoring;
- Assisting with data management;
- Working with a small team, locally, on how best to characterize the relationships between exposure and health data.

Basic Qualifications:

Masters level education or equivalent work experience; data analysis skills; experience in the environmental or health field, a plus.

Organization Description: EHP is a non-profit organization focused solely on the public health consequences of unconventional oil and gas development (UOGD or fracking). The organization is based in McMurray, Pennsylvania with a satellite office of public health professionals in New Haven. EHP has worked with communities in southwest Pennsylvania since 2012, but has broadened its reach to other states over the last two years. We collect air, water, and health information in order to better understand the risks posed by the industrial activity, and to convey that understanding to residents, decision-makers, and the public at large.

EHP has developed methods to quantify the risk posed to residents and we partner with community members to monitor air and water. We have established a Health Effects Registry for those living near UOGD infrastructure across the country and are developing a series of Health Impact Assessment templates for communities and local government agencies.
